

End to End Seam Stockinette Stitch

This is the method used to join the cast on and bound off edges of a stockinette stitch piece. This is useful for joining areas like the shoulders of a sweater etc.

1. With the right sides face up place the pieces to be joined on a table or other flat surface and line them up.



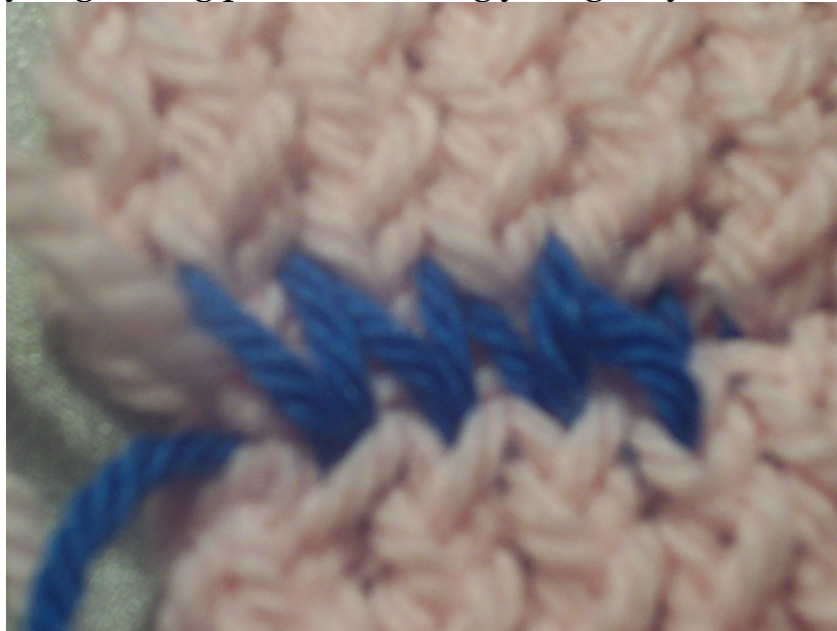
2. With a yarn needle and matching color yarn catch just behind the first 'V' on the right side of the top piece. Pull through taking care to leave a 4 inch tail of your working yarn.



3. Switch to the bottom piece and do the same; catch the needle just behind the first 'V' and pull the working yarn through.



4. Continue alternating from piece to piece catching the 'V's ; as you go along pull the working yarn gently to close up the seam.



Here is what your seam will look like!! Dare ya to find my seam!!
